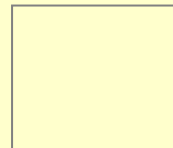

- ✓ Your most recent heat and electric bill
- ✓ Photo ID
- ✓ Written proof of your household GROSS income for the 3 months *prior* to your application, examples such as:
 - Paystubs
 - Child Support Printout
 - Unemployment Printout
 - Social Security Award Letter
 - Self-employed households must provide the appropriate tax forms for verification of income

What is

Home Energy Assistance?

WHEAP assistance is a one-time payment during the heating season (October 1 -May 15). The funding pays a portion of the energy costs, but the payment is not intended to cover the entire cost of heating a residence.

Who May Qualify for Home Energy Assistance?

- Households that pay heating costs directly to a fuel or utility company and have an active utility account.
- Households whose heating costs are included in their rent or make separate payment to landlord may also qualify.
- Households whose total GROSS income for the three months immediately preceding the month of application are at or below the amount shown for your family size:
