

**GREEN LAKE COUNTY  
VETERANS SERVICE COMMISSION  
JULY 12, 2010**

The following are the open minutes of the Quarterly Meeting of the Green Lake County Veterans Service Commission held in the Veterans Service Office at the Health and Human Services Center, Green Lake, WI, at 10:30 A.M. on July 12, 2010.

Members present: Victor Shrock, Tony Soda, Sue Arndt, County Board Chairman Dan Priske, and Gerald Beuthin, Secretary.

**Certification of Open Meeting Law:** The requirements of the Open Meeting Law have been met.

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 10:30 A.M. by Chairman Shrock. After discussion, Arndt made a motion to approve the agenda. Second by Soda. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Action on Minutes:** After discussion, Soda made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 14, 2010, meeting. Second by Arndt. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Appearances & Correspondence:** Priske handed out the flyer for the opening of the new County Facilities.

**Old Business:** Arndt reported that Student Government Day program went very well. Priske stated that he thought it important for the students and the county to keep this program going. Discussion followed about possible changes in the program due to the new building and security changes.

**New Business:** Beuthin reported on the budget guidelines for the 2011 budget and that he will be recommending an increase of \$350 for the Service Commission budget.

Beuthin reported that the County Fair will be held from August 5-8 and that the Veterans office having a booth there is a very good method to get the information out to the public.

Beuthin reported that the Wisconsin State Association of County Veterans Service Commissioners will have their annual meeting in Waupaca on Friday, September 10, and that he will forward the agenda and registration to everyone when he receives it.

Soda reported that the Princeton High School band preformed at King in May and that it went very well.

**Service Office Report:** Beuthin reported that for 2010 contacts were down 4.4%, mail was up 6.3% and VA hospital trips are about even as compared to 2009.

Beuthin reported that he will be attending the WICVSOA Fall Conference in Port Washington the week of October 4-8.

Beuthin reported that there were 12 veteran's deaths in the County since the last meeting.

**Financial Report:** After discussion, Soda made a motion to approve the Financial Report as submitted. Second by Arndt. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Future Meeting Date:** The date for the next meeting will be Monday, October 11, 2010, at 10:30 A.M. Meeting will be in the new County office building.
