WEBSITE UPDATE

Stanuch has updated the website to make it more user friendly. Some questions are still coming up. The new updated County website may help people find the GIS site. Discussion was held.

PLOTTER PURCHASE DISCUSSION WITH IT

Shute was of the impression that the Land Information Budget purchased the plotter but was told that the IT department purchases the plotter. Hutchison stated that the GIS plotter is in the IT budget for this year and he provides the maintenance contract on the plotter.

PLAT BOOK DESIGN AND UPDATE

Jim Hebbe displayed plat books created by Cloud Cartographics of Minnesota and Farm & Home Publications from Iowa. He also detailed a plat book prepared in Dodge County using "Red Barn plat books" software. Jim would like input from the committee regarding what we'd like to see in a plat book. Morris reported that as of this date, we have 304 plat books left.

AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY UPDATE

Al Shute reported that the project will probably be done in 2010. Al received mailings

from a Michigan company. ECRP is talking about putting together a consortium, but if we want the same clarity as we've had in the past it would probably we would have to add money. When we define our project, we will have to get in touch with various companies for pricing.

LAND INFORMATION OFFICER'S REPORT

Carryover funds from 2007 – Al Shute presented the carryover request as detailed on the spreadsheet. *Motion/second(Podgorski/Hebbe)* to carry over \$159,027 from the 2007 Land Information budget to the 2008 budget. Motion carried.

Update Pilot Scanning Project of County Surveyor Records – Shute explained they are using the 2007 grant money for the document scanning of the Surveyor's records. General Code has been contracted and the work will be completed by the end of April. An exact start date has not be determined. They will be doing the work in the basement of the Safety Building and it will take 5 to 6 days. The information will be available electronically on the intranet first and then the internet later. 6000 documents to be scanned. If there are any funds left they will work on the ROD documents.
